



Dear Sunny Slope Water Company Shareholder:

August 20, 2026

Effective **Nov 01, 2026**, Sunny Slope Water Company's rates will increase by 6.5% as shown on the rate table on the reverse side of this letter. Even with this increase, the company's rates remain among the lowest in the San Gabriel Valley.

This rate increase is due to the sharply rising costs of water, electric power, materials, equipment, and labor, along with Sunny Slope's capital improvement program and increased regulatory compliance. The increase will help the company continue upgrading its aging infrastructure to meet its current and future needs.

Over the past five years, Sunny Slope has completed several major projects, including the replacement of multiple water mains, the renovation of Reservoir No. 1 (4 million gallons), and upgrades to chlorine and sanitation lines. In addition, it modernized its booster systems and water quality analyzers.

Currently, the company is approximately halfway through the renovation of Reservoir No. 4 (6 million gallons). These projects are extremely important to maintaining a reliable system that provides safe, high-quality water to your homes and business.

As drinking water regulations continue to change and increase, Sunny Slope must invest in testing equipment, tests, and system improvements to meet current and future regulatory requirements.

Be assured that Sunny Slope's Board of Directors and Staff will continue to manage expenses and maintain tight cost controls to keep water rates as low as possible.
